The Conference will be held on January 23rd, while Doctoral Colloquium will take place on the 22nd of the same. The **XX Grudis Conference and Doctoral Colloquium** is supported by the European Accounting Association and by OCC (Professional Association of Certified Accountants).

Conference Audience

The **XX Grudis Conference and Doctoral Colloquium** is open to anyone with an interest in Accounting research. Submission of full papers and PhD research projects is open to the members of **Grudis** (co-authorship with **Grudis** members is allowed) and members of the EAA. Please contact us at conferencia.grudis@gmail.com if you would like to join **Grudis** or have any questions.

Full papers and research projects written in English and in Portuguese will be accepted. **Authors may only make one paper submission, although they may be co-author or multiple papers. Only one presentation per author will be accepted. As a rule, the presentation and discussion of papers will be in English, except in the case of articles written in Portuguese for which the author may choose Portuguese.**

Key Dates

- Submission (full text) deadline: **1 December 2020**
- Acceptance of papers notification date: **7 January 2021**
- Registration of presenting authors deadline: **11 January 2021**
- General registration deadlines:
 - Early bird rate: **15 January 2021**
 - Regular rate: **21 January 2021**

Submission and Selection of Works

Submissions should be made through *EasyChair*, attaching a file in Pdf format, in which:

- The file must contain only the full version of the text of the research work without any identification of the author (s). This will be the file to be sent to the two evaluators of the work. The information about the authors will be uploaded by the authors, when submitting the work, on the *EasyChair* platform.
- Information about the authors will be uploaded by them, **at the time of submission process**, on the EasyChair platform.
- In the EasyChair **keyphrases field** (when submitting), the following information must be entered:
 - reference to the **type** of work (**Article/Paper**) or PhD Project (**PhD Project**)).
 - Research Methods and Areas (See categories used by EAA).
 - i. **Research method:** Analytical / Modeling; Conceptual Development / Interpretative / Historical; Case / Field Study; Empirical Archival; Experimental; Survey
 - ii. **Accounting areas:** Auditing; Accounting Education; Financial Analysis; Financial Reporting; Accounting and Governance; History; Interdisciplinary/Critical; Accounting and Information Systems; Management Accounting; Public Sector Accounting & Not-For-Profit Accounting; Social and Environmental Accounting & Ethical Issues in Accounting; Taxation.
 - In the case of a PhD Project, the **option** related to **participation in the selection process of the Grudis-EAA protocol should be indicated.**

Works must not exceed 15,000 words.

The submission must be made until December 1, 2020, through the *EasyChair* platform website: XX GCDC Guarda 2021. In a few days more detailed information about the submission process will be sent.

Authors of PhD projects written in English should indicate through the *EasyChair* system and also via email conferencia.Grudis@gmail.com if they wish to participate in the **Grudis**-EAA protocol selection process.
